CLUB BYLAWS



CLUB BYLAWS SINCE 1995

Duties of Coach's

- 1/1 To arrange a day and time suitable for coaching and to notify the club secretary.
- 1/2 In the event of a coach being unable to attend a game, the coach will notify the team manager.
- 1/3 Collect all team equipment and then be responsible for it during the season. Match balls must not be used for practice.
- 1/4 Ensure that all players leave the park after training, or stay with them until they are uplifted.
- 1/5 The coach has full control of players during the game, within the rules of the relevant federation.

Duties of Managers

- 2/1 Notify players of game times by each Thursday.
- 2/2 Help arrange transport for players to and from games.
- 2/3 Ensure that players are turned out for games in full club uniform.
- 2/4 Notify results of games as per club requirements.
- 2/5 Ensure all players have removed jewellery: e.g. watch's, piercings etc. before each game.
- 2/6 Keep team shirts and distribute before each game and collect in after each game.

General

- 3/0 No smoking or drinking is permitted on the side-line of ANY game or training session.
- 3/1 All midget and junior players must be given equal playing time.
- 3/2 The coach may stand down a player as a disciplinary measure.
- 3/3 All games outside the normal weekly games should be notified in writing to and approved by the Committee.
- 3/4 Club uniforms must be treated with care and should only be worn for match's only.
- 3/5 All players are expected to be available to play every week.
- 3/6 Players are not eligible to transfer to other clubs whilst still owing money or having unreturned club gear.
- 3/7 Players are responsible for any fines and related costs incurred while playing for the club. Upon the club receiving notification of the fine, it will in turn, invoice the player who then has fourteen days to make full payment. Failure to do so will result in that player being ineligible to play for the club until the fine has been paid.
- 3/8 Any player having obtained four (4) disciplinary points will not be allowed to play until they have appeared before the club judiciary committee. (red card = 2, yellow card = 1)

3/9 No fundraising is permitted by teams or individuals unless applied in writing to, and approved by the committee.

3/10 No person is allowed to use club facilities or equipment who owes money, or who has unreturned club equipment from any previous season.

3/11 No individual team is allowed to make any extra rules for their own team players outside the club rules. i.e. No member can be bound by any rules other than those set down by the Clubs constitution and bylaws.

3/12 Any problems arising between coach's, managers, players and parents are to be notified in *Writing*, through the secretary to the committee.

3/13 Swearing is **UNACCEPTABLE** by Spectators and Players.

3/14 No member of the club or their guardian can approach the media without permission from the club's committee.

General Rules at Games.

- Please note that these rules are set out by the relevant federations and must be adhered to by the whole club.
- All players must wear shin pads.
- All players must have their own drink bottle .
- All cuts must be dressed and covered. Any bleeding must be stopped before player is allowed on the field.
- Absolutely <u>NO</u> parents, children or coaches are allowed behind the goal line during the course of a game.
- All games must start on time. If for some reason a game starts late, it must be shortened to allow the next game to start on time.
- No over age players are allowed unless they have been approved by the relevant federation.
- All jewellery must be removed before games.
